



DATES AND DEADLINES 2024-25

Early September 2024

- UCAS Apply (website) opens for applications for 2025 entry (and deferred entry in 2026).

15 September 2024

- Applicants for Law must have registered for the [LNAT Assessment](#) (to be taken by 15 October 2024).

16 September 2024

- Applicants for Chemical Engineering and Biotechnology, Engineering, Natural Sciences and Veterinary Medicine must have applied for the [ESAT](#).
- Applicants for Computer Science must have registered for the [TMUA](#).

19 September 2024

- Applicants for Medicine must have registered for the [UCAT](#) (to be taken by 26 September 2024).

15 October 2024

- Deadline for UCAS applications. Remember the deadline is 18:00 (6.00pm) UK time.

22 October 2024

- Deadline for completion and submission of My Cambridge Application.
- Remember to submit by 18:00 (6.00pm) UK time. Students that are required to submit a transcript should also submit by this date.
- Extenuating Circumstances form deadline for applicants who have experienced particular personal or educational disadvantage, where information additional to that given in the teacher reference is needed.

04 November 2024

- Deadline for submission of written work (if your course requires this – please see individual subject pages for more details of what is required for your course).
- Deadline for Disability Adjustments and Allowances at Interview Form for relevant applicants (this form will be circulated by email and should be returned using the Applicant Document Upload Form, the link to which is provided to applicants).

Mid November - late November 2024

- If you are being called to interview, you will receive an email from the College with full details of arrangements. We will give applicants as much notice as possible, and this can vary based on subject. All applicants should be notified by 4 December 2024, so please do not contact our office before then to enquire about the status of your application.

Late November (19 November onwards)

- College-Registered Assessments to take place. If you are invited to sit one of these assessments, you will be notified via email in mid-November.

December 2024

- Interviews. Interviews will be conducted over Zoom, with the majority taking place between 5 December and 18 December.

24 January 2025

- We will send you an email telling you the outcome of your application and UCAS will be updated:

We may offer you a place, conditional or unconditional, at Newnham College.

We may tell you that your application was unfortunately unsuccessful and that you have not obtained a place at Newnham or any other Cambridge College.

If we are unable to offer you a place, but think that other Colleges may be interested in your application, we will have placed your file in the Winter Pool. You may be selected by another College, who should also contact you on the same day.

Early February 2025

- Deadline for submission requests for feedback on unsuccessful applications.

It is our policy to send this feedback to the applicants' schools or colleges, because we feel that teachers are best placed to put the information in context. If an applicant is no longer at school or college, we are happy to send the feedback directly. We regret that, due to GDPR, we are unable to engage in any discussion with parents, unless we have the written permission of the applicants concerned. Further information on feedback requests will be made available after the January Decision Communication date. In the case of formal complaints, we follow the University's complaints procedure. Mid-February 2025

- Deadline for applications for Choral Awards.

August 2025

- Examination results published and confirmation of conditional offers for 2024 entry (or deferred entry in 2026) that have been met – all conditional offers must be met by the deadline set by UCAS unless otherwise specified.
